All classes (except TTXGP) are organized according to Swedish Roadracing regulations and Scandinavian Open invitation. TTXGP is organised according to UEM sporting Regulations and TTXGP technical regulations with the following additional information.

Entryfee for Junior Cup is: 800 SEK, All other classes 2700 SEK Late fee according to invitation.

Payment with credit cards or cheque at the circuit cannot be accepted.

### 9 Registration, Technical Inspection and other formalities

Before entrance to the technical inspection, the bikes will be checked that their numbers are according to the rules. Wrong numbers/colours/backgrounds means you are not allowed into the technical inspection.

The rider should check in personally and not by proxy (another person). Neither rider nor machine is permitted onto the track unless he/it has passed the technical inspection, which will be held according to the following schedule. No technical inspection is necessary before the paying practises held (before Saturday).

**Pit Silence:** According to Swedish regulations and laws, the pit silence is between 20.00 and 08.00 every day. Note: It's not allowed to make any damage to the asphalt in the pit area. The rider will be penalised by  $100 \in$  for each small hole in the asphalt and  $1000 \in$  for bigger damages.

**Riders Briefing:** Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> of September 08.00 for Junior Cup riders, and for the other Scandinavian Open/Swedish Championship/Cup classes at Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> of September 08.30 and for TTXGP by the TTXGP organisation, time to be announced. All meetings are at the Timekeeping building.

# **10 Practising**

It's strictly forbidden to ride racing motorcycles from participants on the circuit outside the official practice periods. The minimum number of laps (during the free or official practices) to be qualified is 3. The practice session will be as follows:

# 12: Pit lane speed penalties

A speed limit of 50 km/h will be enforced in the pit lane at all times during the event. If a rider exceeds the limit during practice or race, he will be penalized according to the Swedish Regulations. As a general rule, all fines must be paid before the end of the event.

13: Environmental: Riders must take used tires and petrol cans with him from the track. The track owner will charge a fee of 500 SEK for each can/tire left at the track.

Prizegiving ceremony will be held after the each race at the podium. The 1-2-3 in each race will be awarded cups.

**14 B:** Travel reimbursement for Scandinavian Open series entered riders: According to the Scandinavian Open invitation 2011.

# **15 Protests**

All protests must be in accordance with the requirements of the Swedish Regulations.

There will be **NO** fuel supplied by the organiser in the paddock.

## 18: Transponder:

Transponders (AMB TranX 260) will be used, the rent for this transponder is  $60 \in$  per transponder (100 SEK for junior riders). Unreturned transponders will be debited afterwards with an extra charge of  $350 \in$ .

## 19 Start of race and practices:

Riders will be let out on track 4 by 4 at all practices and races. The warm up lap will be started as a Butterfly start where the marshal with the red flag will run thru the startgrid and let one startline at a time to start their warm up lap.
